Rules:

1. The competition will be conducted in line with IMSSU rules and SAMSSA in-house rules.
2. The championship will commence at 08h30 on 13 May 2025 and finish on 16 May 2026, after which shootouts will commence.
3. Weapon certification will be done at any time during the competition. It is the responsibility of each shooter to ensure that his/her firearms conform to the rules, meaning that any non-conforming firearm will forfeit its score.
4. Official shooting starts at 08h30 each morning. Please note that shooters who miss their allocated squadding, forfeit their chance to participate in that particular item.
5. The **closing date for entries is 17 April 2026**. Entry fees are payable before this date to Steenbok shooting club. (Nedbank Steenbok skietklub Ac: 1764305302 code: 176436. Please put your initials and surname as reference.
6. Squadding details will be available on the SAMSSA web page.
7. Sighting-in/practise can be done from 07h00 – 08h00 every morning. No firearms may be handled or shots fired at any time when no Range officer is available, not even with practice sessions.

Indeling versoeke (Squadding)

- a) 10 items mag van Woensdag tot Saterdag geskiet word per persoon.
- b) Donderdag mag jy vier items skiet.
- c) Vrydag mag jy vier items skiet.
- d) Saterdag mag jy twee items skiet.
- e) Alle skuts moet beskikbaar wees vir baanoffisier diens. (Let asb. op vir jou indeling.)
- f) Moenie vergeet om jou naam & van, SAMSSA no, e-pos en selfoonnommer op jou inskrywingsvorm in te tik nie, soms vergeet die persoon dit en merk net sy/haar items.
- g) Voltooi asseblief jou vriend wat saam met jou ingedeel moet word, in die versoek blokkie. Let asseblief daarop dat jy en jou vriend verkieslik dieselfde items moet inskryf, indien julle saam ingedeel wil word. Daar moet altyd een afdeling oop gelaat word vir baanoffisier diens.

Squadding requests

- a) 10 items per person from Wednesday to Saturday.
 - b) Thursday four items.
 - c) Friday four items.
 - d) Saturday only two items.
 - e) All shooters must be available for RO duties. (Please notice your RO squadding.)
 - f) Please complete your name, SAMSSA no, e-mail and cell phone number on the entry form.
 - g) Please complete your shooting partner on the entry form as well as requirements. Please notice, if you need to shoot with your friend, please enter for the same items as possible. Please leave one details for RO duty.
8. There will be shootouts for all IMSSU items where there are ties for overall positions (we will not use count back for these items.) We also ask that everyone attend the shootout items as spectators, as it is fun to watch and it is a great part of our sport. There will be no shootout on all other classes and SAMSSA items, except for exact ties.
 9. There must be at least three entries per item for squadding or to win medals at the prize giving. If there are only two entries per item, Steenbok will pay back your entry fee for that item.
 10. Kids enter as u/9, u/14 and u/20. Please mark your entries in your specific age group on a different entry form. Parent, do not use your entry form for your kids please. Every person uses their own entry form.

11. Competitors must be on range 30 min. before their squadded time – both A & B details. A & B details must score for each other. Shooters who fail to do duty as a scorer/range officer, will forfeit his/her score.
12. As decided by SAMSSA members each shooter will be expected to perform RO duties. Shooters who fail to do duty as Range Officer, will forfeit his/her scores. Competitors must make provision in their stay on the range for at least one RO Duty. If possible, you may not shoot an item while you are Range Officer.
13. Please mark an “O” if it is a miss or a “x” if it is a hit on the scorecard directly after each shot. Do not mark after a string is finished.
14. Shooters are responsible for own classifications. Please check your classification and keep every item score for your records. It is the responsibility of each shooter to ensure that his/her scores conform to the classification, meaning that the committee is not responsible if you receive the wrong medal or classification.
15. There will be shootouts for all IMSSU items.
16. Fun items winners will be determined using reverse animal count. Only for exact ties, will there be shootouts.
17. Caterers will be on the range during the day and we ask you to support them please.
18. For this competition targets will be painted white.
19. Shooters are responsible for own target setting up to 100m; if targets are not set at the load command of the first 5 shot string the scores are lost. If targets were set and have subsequently fallen, alibis will be shot.
20. Drug testing may be performed during any part of the competition. Any competitor, who refuses drug testing, will be disqualified from the competition.
21. A protest will be handled according to IMSSU rules. The cost of lodging a protest is R300 (to be paid back in the item that the protest is successful).
22. A medal will be awarded to the first three overall positions ie: Gold, Silver and Bronze per item. A single charcoal medal will be awarded only to deserving class winners for first, second and third positions in all classes. No participation medals will be awarded to persons not in the first three positions per class. The prize giving will be an informal event at the Steenbok shooting range and will commence at 15h00 if possible. Shooters who do not attend the awards function will forfeit their medals. Please you must be present to receive your medals. Steenbok will not keep or distribute medals/awards after Saturday.
23. Participation certificate/s will be posted on the SAMSSA web page.
24. **NO High velocity (1150 fps +) and Ultra velocity .22 ammunition (stingers, blitzer etc.) is allowed on the .22 Small Bore Rifle or .22 Handgun targets.**
25. **No ammunition that causes damage to the targets may be used. The match director will have the right to prohibit the use of certain calibres, or ammunition should he find that it causes damage to the targets. Shooters must test their ammunition prior the competition. Steenbok shooting club will have the right to impose penalties on shooters who damage any targets during this competition. Shooter will replace each targets with damages.**
26. Shooters must behave at all times on the shooting range. Foul language and/or insolent behaviour will not be tolerated.
