GENERAL RULES:

1. Entries

Entries will only be accepted where the competitor has a valid paid-up SAMSSA membership.
Only electronic payments, with proof of payment, will be accepted.

No entry will be accepted or squadded without proof of payment.

2. Competition Fees

Entry Fee Senior: R300
Entry Fee Family: R500
Entry Fee Junior: R200
Event Fee: R40 per item

Late entry fine will be R250 over and above mentioned fees and accepted **ONLY** on the condition that the Squadding and Stats Officer are able to fit in the squadding of such competitor.

Maximum entries are 10 events per competitor, of which only two events may be shot on Saturday.

3. Squadding

As decided at the SAMSSA AGM, each competitor will be expected to perform Range Officer (RO) duties as per squadding details. Competitors who fail to do duty as RO, will forfeit their scores.

Competitors must make provision in their time on the range for at least one RO duty.

You may not shoot an event while you are performing RO duties.

Competitors who enter for 10 events may be squadded back to back (to allow for RO duties) which implies that the

competitor should arrange for his/her own spotter/scorer.

Please note that competitors who miss their allocated squadding, forfeit their chance in that particular event.

4. Targets and Target Setting

Targets will be painted white on the one side.

If you prefer, please bring your own white spray paint.

Competitors are responsible for own target setting up to 100m.

5. Sighting-in

Sighting-in can be done from 07:00 to 08:00 Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

No firearms may be handled or shots fired at any time when no Range Officer is available.

6. Official Competition

Weapon certification may be done at any time. It is the responsibility of each competitor to ensure that his/her firearm/s conform to the rules.

Drug testing may be performed during any part of the competition. Any competitor, who refuses drug testing, will be disqualified from the competition.

Official shooting starts at 08:30 each morning

Competitors must be on the range <u>30 minutes prior</u> to their squadded time – both A & B details.

A & B details must score for each other. Competitors who fail to do duty as a scorer, will forfeit his/her score.

After every 20 shots your neighbor must initial your score card on the right hand side.

Winners will be determined by reverse animal count. Only with exact ties, will there be a shoot-off.

Shoot-offs will commence at 15:00 on Saturday (see details below).

Protest will be handled according to IMSSU rules. The cost of lodging a protest is R200 (to be paid back in the event that the protest is successful).

7. Medals and Achievement Bars

Competitors who do not attend the awards function should make special arrangements with fellow competitors to obtain their medals. Neither GMSSA nor WH will keep or distribute medals after the competition. Medals will be awarded as follows:

- Participation medals will be awarded to all participating competitors.
- No achievement bars will be issued.

8. Certificates

All competitors who compete at the Championship will be issued, free of charge but only in electronic format, with a "GMSSA Participation Certificate", reflecting the items he/she competed in, including the class and scores achieved per item.

9. Catering

Caterers will be on the range during on Friday and Saturday and we ask for you to support them please.

There will be a cash bar for prize giving , please join us at the clubhouse.
